Sir/Madam,

- 1) This is with reference to an appeal vide ref. No. BJP/LUMC/GYP/EXP-2025-26/1266 dated 26.08.2025 submitted by the Principal, Luqman Unani Medical College & Hospital, BL Karadi Campus, 12, Naubag, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka (Inst. ID UNI0287) to the Commission, against the order passed by the President, MARBISM vide letter of even no. dated 05.08.2025 with regards to issuance of permission with seat Reduction in UG (BUMS) Course for the Academic year 2025-26. Further, on verification of the submitted appeal following conclusion has been drawn: -

a) Shortcomings of Non-teaching staff: - Availability of Non-Teaching staff is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{20}{21} \times 100\% = 96.66\%$

- 2) Therefore, in view of the above and in accordance with Regulation 16 (3) (f) of MESAR UG (Unani), 2023, the Chairman, NCISM decided to accept the submission made by the Principal, Luqman Unani Medical College & Hospital, BL Karadi Campus, 12, Naubag, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka (Inst. ID UNI0287) with regard to reconsider the 03 seats reduced in the yearly permission granted for admission in U.G.

(BUMS) course, for the academic session 2025-26, under Section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 & relevant regulations there under vide order no. 11-13/2025-26/MARB (UNANI) dated 05.08.2025.


- 3) Further, a letter vide **Ref. no. 51-05/2025-26/Comm. Appeal/College (Unani) dated 08.09.2025** has been received from the Secretary, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to grant permission to **Luqman Unani Medical College & Hospital, BL Karadi Campus, 12, Naubag, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka (Inst. ID UNI0287)** for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 as per concerned act and regulations.

"DECISION"

- 4) Therefore, in view of above, **Luqman Unani Medical College & Hospital, BL Karadi Campus, 12, Naubag, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka (Inst. ID UNI0287)** is hereby granted with :-
- a) **Yearly Permission in UG (BUMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course and 07 seats in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Moalajat- 04 seats and (ii) Ilmu Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan- 03 seats for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 16 (2) & (3) (h) of MESAR UG Unani 2023 & Regulation 16 (8) (g) of MESAR PG Unani, 2024.**
- 5) **The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-**
- I. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate & postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course and 07 seats in 02 PG courses** respectively shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted there under.**
- II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 6) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
- 7) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 9) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters with vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
- 10) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB-ISM by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made there under should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
- iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for Postgraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.

11) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
